The project is out for bid with a Prebid scheduled for March 5th, bids due March 26th, the Project will be awarded on April 3rd, 2019. Member Lamar made a motion to approve the Anixter quote for a not to exceed \$60,153.17 for materials to proceed with the 69kV reroute. Secretary Jim Urban seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- 5. Legal Counsel Jeff Jacob asked the Board to approve a Professional Services Agreement with Sondhi Solutions. This Agreement will address the Utilities services separate from the City. Member Lamar motioned to approve the 2019 Consulting and Professional Services Agreement with Sondhi Solutions. Secretary Urban seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- 6. Secretary Urban made a motion to approve the claims dated February 6th, 2019 for \$672,868.96 and February 20th, 2019 for \$1,660,194.51. Vice Chairman Stoner seconded the motion. Motion carried with Member Lamar abstaining.
- 7. Chairman Taylor asked for any other business that may be brought before the Board. Chairman Taylor thanked Tracey Bowles for his service to the Utilities as Trace's last day will be February 28th, 2019.
